Sleaford Town Hall Room Hire

Thank you for enquiring about the rooms that Sleaford Town Council have available to hire at Sleaford Town Hall.

Situated in the attractive Quayside House in Navigation Yard, Sleaford Town Hall incorporates the Sleaford Town Council offices, together with facilities and three rooms available for hire.

The Town Hall is positioned within the centre of the town, with convenient parking close by in Eastgate Car Park.

The Town Hall is serviced by a lift, as well as stairs to the first floor. We are able to provide use of a hot water urn, water jugs, cups and saucers, crockery and cutlery, as well as a large tv screen which can be connected to a laptop.

The Town Hall can accommodate up to 60 people at any one time time, due to health and safety and fire regulations.

Upon your booking, we will liaise with you as to the best room to suit your needs because capacity depends upon the room layout. We are able to put the rooms into any layout that you wish with our tables and chairs.

We have three rooms available to hire, these being:

The Council Chamber - this room is situated on the first floor of the Town Hall and is our largest room to hire, being able to accommodate up to 60 people (theatre style). Capacity will depend on the room layout. This room is suitable for larger type meetings.

The Community Room - this room is situated on the ground floor and is light and airy. It is suitable for community use such as exercise, art, community group gatherings, charity groups etc. The room is able to accommodate up to 40 people (theatre style). Capacity will depend on the room layout.

HMS Sheldrake Room - this room is situated on the first floor and has displays of Town Twinning and RAF links within it. The room is suitable for smaller type meetings and can accommodate up to 30 people (theatre style). Capacity will depend on the room layout.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, we have put safety procedures in place to protect our staff and room hirers. Please find the details below:

There is a QR code on the wall in reception for people to scan with their mobile phone if they wish for track and trace.

In the daytime, masks must be worn upon entering and exiting the Town Hall and also in the communal areas, ie. the reception area and the toilets.

The ladies toilets in the Town Hall are currently for use by staff only. All visitors are to use the disabled toilet on the ground floor please.

We will not be able to provide any drink refreshments or cups, cutlery etc. Hirers are welcome to bring their own flasks or water bottles. The kitchen will be completely out of use to hirers. This will be reviewed regularly.

A fire alarm drill is now carried out every Monday at 10.00am. Hirers are not expected to leave the building whilst the drill takes place. However, if the fire alarm goes off at any time other than the set drill time, hirers must leave the building. The fire safety point is in Eastgate Car Park, to the side of The Hub which is opposite our green tractor shed.

Each hiring group must have a register/form that is taken inside the room that you have hired, to record everyone that attends the booking. This is for fire safety reasons. The register/form is to be provided by the hirer.

There will be an accident report book in the room that you hire which will be available for you to enter any incidents that may occur.

Please read through the Conditions of Use for Room Hire document, complete and sign the enclosed booking form and return it to our offices to secure your booking. An invoice for payment will be sent to you once we have received your booking form.
